Chairman Blumberg convened the meeting at 9:35 a.m.

- The minutes from the July 25, 2018 open session were reviewed and approved as submitted.
- David has been asked to be a mentor for APAI in September in Colorado.
- Christine is attending a meeting this morning in Prince George's County regarding releases and parole hearings.
- There will be no Commission meeting on September 19, 2018; the Chairman will be off in observance of Yom Kippur.
- We will work with Patuxent Institution with parole violators. They will send a list of whom they have and the file will be given to the issuing commissioner for review.
- The local detention centers are under no obligation to hold DOC inmates.
- Commissioners will begin receiving files of federal offenders to possibly recall the retake warrant, or if there is enough state time, the warrant can be withdrawn and be revisited 30 days prior to federal time being completed for reinstatement.
- A new report is needed from DPP if a warrant was previously withdrawn on an identical statement of charges.

➤ **Do not issue a subpoena if the case is past expiration.**
